### **Enjoy a Traditional Greek Feast on Easter Sunday at Jim's Place East**

"It was cooked on a traditional spit with charcoal while the kids played on the grounds."

Guests can remain true to the Greek tradition and choose roast leg of lamb, prepared with a special blend of Grecian spices, on Easter Sunday. Other delectable choices on the lunch menu include another Greek favorite from an original recipe, souflima (a savory pork entrée), along with American and southern dishes like Mississippi pecan crusted catfish, Norwegian salmon prepared with lemon oregano sauce, charcoal-grilled rib eye steak, parmesan chicken and a variety of fresh vegetables and homemade bread. Signature desserts include Chantilly key lime pie and chocolate mousse pie.

Today, Jim's Place retains the beauty of a retreat in the woods. The restaurant's many windows provide views of colorful azaleas and grand trees while dining. And children are still welcomed to skip across the lawn as they pass an occasional squirrel.

"Easter Sunday is a time when families seek out a special place to celebrate after church while the kids are dressed up in finest attire," said Liollo. "We're happy to open our doors to share our tradition with them."
